MIXING DIRECTIONS

Thoroughly mix 4080 Beef Supplement with grain or complete feed before feeding. <u>DO NOT FEED ALONE</u>. Mix 150 lbs. of 4080 Beef Supplement with 1850 lbs. of feed or feed ingredients to make one ton of *Type C Medicated Feed* containing 22.5 grams of *Monensin* per ton.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed the complete ration at the rate of 10 - 29 lbs./head/day to cattle weighing 800 lbs, to provide 112.5 - 326.25 milligrams of *Monensin* per head per day. Provide cattle continuous access to clean, cool water. Store feed in a cool, dry location free of insects, rodents, and other pests. Do not feed if mold or infestation occurs.
